## Lagan Valley Day procedure centre helping to reduce waiting lists

Health Minister Mike Nesbitt has highlighted the role of Elective Care Centres in helping to reduce our lengthy waiting lists.

Dedicated capacity for elective surgery has been enhanced through continued development of these surgical hubs across Northern Ireland. A key benefit is that this planned surgery is less likely to be cancelled due emergency pressures.
Procedure Centres (DPCs) are operational at Lisburn's Lagan Valley and Omagh Hospitals supporting a range of surgical specialities. From October 2020 to March 2024, approximately 20,000 patients were treated at the DPCs. There are also three Elective Overnight Stay Centres (EOSCs) at the Mater Hospital, Belfast, South West Acute Hospital (SWAH) in Enniskillen, and Daisy Hill Hospital In for intermediate complexity surgery

may require an overnight stay in hospital. Between April 2023 and March 2024, more than 12,000 patients have been treated across all three sites. There are also Cataracts Centres at Downe (Downpatrick), Tyrone (Dungannon) and Mid Ulster (Magherafelt) Hospitals, and orthopaedic hub at Belfast's Musgrave Park Hospital which includes the Duke of Connaught Unit, a dedicated orthopaedic Day Procedure Centre. The Minister oaid a visit to the Elective Overnight Stay Centre at South West Acute Hospital. Elective general surgery, gynaecology, breast surgery, paediatric surgery and paediatric dental procedures are carried out at SWAH for long waiting patients from the region, with consultants visiting from other hospitals.

Seven years ago, the Helicopter Emergency Medical Service (HEMS) made its inaugural call out to aid 11 year old Conor from Castlewellan following a farming accident, and since then has been needed on over 4,300 occasions, averaging twice per day.

The unique partnership between Northern Ireland Ambulance Service and the Charity Air Ambulance NI, operating 365 days a year, brings a transformative change with its combination speed and medical expertise. Staffed by a doctor consultant paramedic from NIAS, and supported by the charity providing the helicopter, pilot, and engineering the services, has markedly enhanced emergency care.

NIAS Operational Lead for HEMS Glenn O'Rorke said, "Anyone could be a patient and need the air ambulance to fly to them. The crew is tasked to incidents including road traffic collisions, farm, sports or workplace incidents, accidents at home or serious medical emergencies such as cardiac arrest."

One such patient is Damien Laverty from Carryduff Building Supplies who suffered a severe arm injury at work. The rapid response and advanced medical care provided by the HEMS team working alongside their NIAS road crew colleagues was crucial in saving his arm and facilitating his recovery.

Northern Ireland Fire and Rescue Service worked to release Damien's arm from the machinery and once freed, Damien was anaesthetised by the HEMS Doctor and transferred to the Royal Victoria Hospital, Belfast

Speaking about experience, Damien said: "It has been a long journey to recovery, but I have made great progress. I owe so much to the air ambulance team, the Northern Ireland Ambulance Service and to the Royal Victoria Hospital for my initial care and treatment. I was at risk of losing my arm but thankfully it was saved and I am back to work. The air ambulance costs £6,850 per day to run so every penny really does go a long way to making sure that this vital service can continue."

The service operates 365 days of the year for 12 hours per day and the aircraft can get to the furthest locations in NI from its airbase in Lisburn in approximately 25 minutes.

Running at a cost of £6,850 per day, the service relies heavily on public donations to meet its annual £2.5 million funding requirement. Breige Mulholland, Head of Operations and Finance at Air Ambulance NI, expressed gratitude for the community's support and emphasized the importance of continued fundraising efforts, "We would like to take this opportunity to

extend our sincere thanks to NIAS and the Department of Health for their continued Each time the support. helicopter lifts off we are aware that someone is in great need and that, thanks to the generosity of people locally, the HEMS team can respond and give hope. We are truly grateful everyone who has been able to support us over the past 7 years and ask for continued support."

## First sod cut at Laurelhill Sports Zone

LCCC have invested £1.7 million to develop a new full size 3G soccer pitch at Laurelhill Sports Zone.



Construction has commenced and will see the creation of one new 3G pitch and additional parking, which will complement the existing synthetic hockey pitch currently on site. The project is expected to be completed in March 2025.

The improved facility will be used by both Laurelhill Community College and Killowen Primary School as part of their curriculum. The wider community can also book the pitch outside of term time as well as at evenings and weekends.

## **ROYAL BRITISH LEGION SELECTS** LISBURN VETERAN FOR TEAM UK **AT 2025 INVICTUS GAMES**

Stuart "Stu" Ball from Lisburn, Northern Ireland has been selected by the Royal British Legion to represent Team UK at the Invictus Games in Canada in 2025 - the first Games to include winter sports.

partnership with MOD, the RBL has proudly revealed a 64-strong team, who are all wounded, injured and sick serving personnel and veterans.

The team have been preparing at the RBL's Battle Back Centre Back Centre
Lilleshall. With Battle challenging physical and mental injuries sustained while serving the UK either at home or abroad. multi-generational team includes participants from all services who have been selected based on the benefit that the Games will contribute towards their recovery.

Stu described it as "fantastic" to be selected for Team UK. He said "I think this is hopefully going to be the start of a new me and I'm very excited for where this journey could take me and my family."

Stu joined the British Army at just 16 years old, and conducted his first tour to Iraq when he was 18. Working 18. Force Protection, Stu's role was escorting convoys from Kuwait to their new destinations in Iraq. Stu has travelled all over the world with the

Army, including tours of Afghanistan and the Falklands. As a vehicle support specialist, Stu would meet a high turnover of troops coming to him for vehicles and says "9 times out of 10 you'd be having a brew with somebody, you'd give them a vehicle, and then a week or two later vehicles could come back in and all those people you talked to, had a brew with. or had some banter and a laugh with are being flown home repatriated whilst you're stood at their vigil. It's quite a hard thing to get my head round." Stu was inspired by

an athlete he watched on an Invictus Games documentary from Canada who had a similar mental injury to him, and thought "if he can do it, why can't I". He added: "this Invictus journey has given me that sense of purpose and identity again, as I'd lost all that. I went from feeling 'I'll give this a go', to 'I need this now' to help me move on. Especially as my treatment's due to start soon I'm hoping that can work hand in hand with Invictus.'

Established in 2014 by Prince Harry, the Invictus



Games is an international adaptive multi-sport event wounded, injured, and sick servicemen and women, both serving and veterans to participate in as part of their recovery journey.

The Invictus Games Vancouver Whistler 2025 will take place from 8-16 February. The Games utilise the power of sport to inspire recovery and support rehabilitation. showcase the fortitude and resilience of military and personnel their families, improve respect and understanding for those with disabilities, and those who serve or have

served their country

While the RBL is well known for supporting veterans of the Second World War, the charity also supporting younger veterans from more recent conflicts through their recovery journey. 

## **RAGWORT – A NOXIOUS NUISANCE OR A LIFE LINE FOR MOTHS?**

**JV Allister reports** 

When I was growing up in north Armagh, was aware that the yellow-flowered plant I called ragweed had a bad reputation, designated as a 'noxious weed' which should be destroyed on agricultural land. I remember cutting them down with a toy sword.

Recently I observed a slight spat on social media after someone photographed a ragwort plant in a local park and demanded that this 'poisonous plant', a danger to livestock, and perhaps other beings, should be removed. This triggered a bit of a pile-on of supportive comments.

helpfully someone pointed out that there were unlikely to be horses, cows or other livestock grazing in the park, I thought I should try my hand at explaining a bit more about this plant. First, ragwort is not

some sort of alien invader, it is a native plant. Second, yes, it is poisonous if eaten livestock, particularly horses, and a very real problem if it contaminates hay or other fodder, and should definitely be removed anywhere near from paddocks or other land used by livestock.

The other side of this



particular coin is that, as with all native plants, it has a role to play in nature. It is attractive to and feeds many insects such as moths and butterflies and is the specific foodplant of the beautiful black-and-red

cinnabar moth whose black-and-yellow-barred caterpillars sometimes cover the plant, totally stripping the leaves.

So, if you see a ragwort blooming on a roadside, it doesn't need to be

removed unless it could contaminate pasture; you never know, it might have moth eggs attached, whose occupants, when they hatch, will likely gobble



## Planning your dream kitchen

How to plan a kitchen layout. Aesthetics aside (for now!), let's look at some of the key recommendations for planning a kitchen layout that'll give you ultimate functionality.

The work triangle. This is perhaps the most important factor to consider in your kitchen layout. The 'work triangle' is the positioning of your oven, fridge, and sink, which are the three most commonly used items in the kitchen. It's impractical and dangerous to carry pans of hot water the length of the kitchen to drain pasta or vegetables, for example.

As a general rule, aim for no more than a step and half in distance between the three points of your 'work triangle', i.e. your oven, fridge, and sink. It's useful to have a work surface to put things on next to the fridge/ freezer and the hob/oven (making sure the latter is heatproof).

Avoid positioning the oven right next to a wall or tall cupboard – it's best to have some free space either side for comfortable working. Don't forget electrical sockets. You want at least one double socket for every 1.5m of wall space, plus sockets at floor level for the vacuum, for example.

How will you use the space? There's a reason why the kitchen is affectionately known as 'the heart of the home'. People naturally gravitate to the kitchen and it can often be one of the busiest areas of the house. Avoid the daily chaos sweeping through the kitchen with some clever planning. Create a dedicated area before you enter the



kitchen for items such as coats, shoes, and bags. This could be a bench and storage in a specific section of the kitchen, or a mudroom or utility if you have the space.

Perfect positioning. Make sure the primary passageway through the kitchen is unobstructed, i.e. that the oven or dishwasher doesn't open into this space. Passageways need to be wide enough to stand and open the doors of appliances.

If planning a kitchen island, make sure it doesn't block the area in front of your main appliances, leaving enough room to open the appliance doors

and pass by. If work surfaces are opposite each other, plan enough space between them so that two people can work comfortably at the same time.

Kitchen designers will often place the sink first and design the rest of the kitchen layout from there. Whether it's for food prep or clearing up, the sink is a well-used space within the kitchen. The ideal spot? Place it with a view, either by a window, or facing into the room, on a kitchen island, for example.

It's generally more cost effective, and easier to install a proper ventilation system, if the oven is placed on an exterior wall.

Maximise the available space. When planning your kitchen layout, think about the storage you'll need and where this will be.

With some imagination

and creativity, your kitchen walls can be cleverly into a range of different solutions. storage cabinets are a traditional for solution storing crockery and food, with glass-fronted cabinets for housing glassware. Pantry storage increasingly becoming popular to hide away small appliances such as the coffee machine and toaster, baking accessories, and dry food items Open wall hooks and overhead racks for saucepans can add to the kitchen's overall aesthetic Need help visualising your plans? Hiring an experienced kitchen designer will make your life easier in planning your dream space.

A kitchen renovation project can range in price depending on the scope of the work, the complexity of the design, and the finishes you choose. addition to furniture and lighting ensure there's enough space to comfortably move around the room – 'empty' space is key to help increase the feeling of spaciousness.

Step three – colour

Now it's time scheme. to add your personality to the space. With lots of inspiration out there, it can be hard to know how to narrow down your choices. Start with a mood board. You can either do this the old-fashioned cutting out images from magazines, or use an app such as Pinterest. Mowing also blocks out weeds and makes the grass more hardwearing. During the growing season, mowing the lawn can take up quite a lot of time. That's why it's so important you know how to cut grass the right way. In this post, we'll guide you through how to mow a lawn and some useful grass cutting tips to make sure every last detail is covered.

Read on for the best lawn mowing tips and tricks.

1. Get your mower serviced regularly. Getting your mower serviced at the start of every growing season is important to ensure a clean, quality cut. Chipped or blunt blades will bruise the grass and cause a silver sheen or frayed look to the lawn. Also, don't forget to clean out your mower regularly to avoid a build-up of clippings.

2. Know how often to mow. How often you mow depends on the style of lawn you want, weather conditions and the speed your grass is growing. Here's some grass cutting advice: The more frequently you mow, the denser your lawn will be In spring, grass cutting less early needs frequently as it grows more slowly at this time of year. Cut fortnightly until the weather warms up in late spring Lawns need cutting weekly in late spring and summer. You may even need to mow twice weekly when growth rates peak in late spring If you mow less frequently you'll break the 'one third rule' as you'll have to cut off more

than a third of the grass height to keep it looking neat . Milder winters mean lawns may benefit from occasional mowing between late autumn and early spring. Let your new lawn grow to 5cm (2in) tall before mowing for the first time. Choose the highest blade setting so the mower doesn't get choked with clippings.
If the grass is really

long, you may need to strim it first dry shady areas under trees may need less frequent mowing than areas in full sun with good moisture levels 3. Get the grass height right. One of the key grass

cutting tips to a lush lawn is knowing what height to leave the grass. Most lawn grass is best kept at 2.5cm -4cm tall.

Leave it a little longer in patches that get more wear and are heavily used, say 4cm – 5cm. In the shade. vou could leave it still longer, at 7cm-8cm.

4. Adjust the cutting height.Cutting the grass at the correct height will help your lawn stay dense and healthy.

To do this, you'll need to adjust the height to suit the weather and season. The mower should be

on the highest setting for the year's first cut. After that, aim to keep grass around 4cm tall in spring, autumn, and winter, and about 2.5cm in summer. If it's a hot summer, it's a good idea to raise the cutting height of your mower blades to leave the lawn longer. This will make it less prone to going brown in dry weather. The longer grass also retains extra moisture, helping to keep the lawn green and offering shade to the soil.

5. Mow in fine weather. mowing your lawn when it is wet, or temperatures are too

cold. If you cut the Avoid

grass when the ground is soaked, the mower will smear the soil and grass clippings will clump together.

Mowing should wait frosts have until passed. With milder winters and the grass continuing to grow all year, many of us are

now cutting our lawns all year round to some degree.

Alternatively hire a professional gardener to cut your grass!


