LADY MARY'S WOODLAND WALK **OFFICIALLY OPENS**

A new walking trail honouring Lady Mary Peters has been officially opened by the Olympic gold medallist and the Mayor of Lisburn & Castlereagh City Council, Councillor Kurtis Dickson.

The woodland trail, set within the scenic grounds of Aberdelghy Golf Course, was proposed by pupils at Fort Hill Integrated Primary School in recognition of Ladv Mary's historic victory at the 1972 Olympic Games

The 1.2km walk links

the Lagan towpath with the golf course and travels down Conway Lane reconnecting with the towpath. Over the past 12 months pupils at Fort Hill Integrated Primary School have worked with Lisburn & Castlereagh City Council to participate in a series

planting schemes designed to enhance the biodiversity of the area.

Council launches sports funding scheme

Lisburn & Castlereagh City Council has launched a funding package to provide much needed financial support to sports clubs across the council area.

Up to £3,000 is available through the Sports Accelerator Fund to assist eligible clubs meet the costs associated with their ongoing development.

The fund will help cover costs towards sports related or specialised equipment, one off sports events or new programmes, club development officer posts or upskilling of coaches and volunteers through coach education and training.

Councillor Time Mitchell Leigues and

Mitchell, Leisure and Community Wellbeing Chair said: "Grassroots sport is the heartbeat of our communities. brings people encourages together, healthy lifestyles, and opportunities creates for people of all ages to grow in confidence and skill. This funding gives our local clubs the support they need to continue making a real difference on the ground – where it matters most."

The Sports Accelerator Fund is open to constituted



sports clubs affiliated with both their National Governing Body and the local Sports Advisory Body, Sport Lisburn & Castlereagh. The grant is exclusively aimed at sports clubs based in the Lisburn & Castlereagh area.

Lisburn & Castlereagh City Council has announced ambitious plans to redevelop its much-loved Play Park at Wallace Park, Lisburn.


The move marks a significant investment in the future of children's play and inclusive outdoor recreation.

Chair of the Communities & Wellbeing Committee, said: "Play is an important part of a child's development and play parks provide important spaces for children to engage in physical and mental activity, social interaction, creativity. Wallace Park is one of our premier serving families, sports clubs, and community groups across the region. This redevelopment offers an exciting opportunity to create a flagship play area that meets the evolving needs of today's children—delivering inclusive, adventure-focused play that nurtures curiosity, learning, and wellbeing."

To ensure the new play

park meets community expectations, public consultations will be held with parents, young people, schools, and community partners.

This redevelopment expected to position Wallace Park as a major local attraction and a regional, even international, destination boosting city centre footfall, supporting regeneration, and

improving connectivity.

Wallace Park is currently home to three football pitches, a changing pavilion, indoor tennis courts, a multisports area, and the historic Lisburn Cricket Club. It also regularly welcomes high-profile events like the Mayor's Family Fun Day and Twilight Nights.

Lisburn and Castlereagh City Council owns and manages 52 play areas across the council area, ranging from local playgrounds to larger play destinations such as Wallace Park, Hillsborough Forest and Moira Demesne.



beyond. Most reptiles, and all birds of course, lay eggs, but our female common lizards give birth to live young. In more southern, warmer climes, common lizards are known to lay eggs.

While their overall numbers here are not exactly known, it's thought likely that they are in decline, mainly because of habitat loss; and the extensive wildfires this year will have destroyed precious habitat for many

years to come, as well as killing many lizards. Despite their adaptations, they live precarious lives, particularly as weather patterns change and people stupid things like setting fire to wild places.

Incidentally, St. Patrick didn't banish the snakes from Ireland, for the simple reason that there were none in his time, since before the last Ice Age. Rather, it seems that snakes served as an allegory for paganism,

which Patrick 'banished' as he brought Christianity to our shores

Myths and legends have their place in our folk memories, but we also need to know the stories about our highly adaptable native wildlife, and in the case of common lizards, protect our only native reptile.





When asked why they were not a fan of bigger cars, 15% of those surveyed felt these types of vehicles use too much fuel, while a further 15% said they were too expensive to buy.

Meanwhile, 14% were put off by the potentially higher cost of car insurance, while 11% pointed to larger cars being more difficult to park.

Only 11% said they liked bigger claiming they felt safer driving these vehicles. Despite all the 'upscaling' going on Despite in the motoring world, it would appear the public seem to prefer a smaller option.

A resounding 85% those surveyed admitted they thought that the bigger the car, the more the insurance is likely to be, this however, is not always the case

Size alone is unlikely to affect insurance Chances premiums. are, bigger cars may be more expensive as they have more advanced technology on board, more powerful engines or in general, are more expensive buy - all of which will likely have an effect on the price of the car insurance.

When it comes other motoring trends, interest in the electric car option is starting to pick up pace, but drivers are being warned that unforeseen issues may lead to higher costs and higher insurance premiums. To replace an electric car battery for example, could cost from £4.000 to £16,500 depending on the type of car and the size of the battery. *




